DIRECTIONS TO ROCKY NECK

To get to Rocky Neck, drive northeast on Route 128 to Gloucester. Go through two rotaries, staying on 128. Then go straight, through two traffic lights, and up the hill onto East Main Street. Stay on East Main for about a mile, bearing right at the bottom of the hill, and follow East Main as it curves around the harbor. Many artists and businesses are located along East Main in the East Gloucester Arts District. Turn right onto Rocky Neck Avenue, park in the public parking lot, and explore the many shops and galleries on the Neck.

ROCKY NECK ART COLONY

Rocky Neck is a picturesque artists' community that overlooks Gloucester harbor. It began as an isolated sheep pasture and eventually became a hub of maritime industry, centered on the famed Tarr & Wonson Copper Paint Manufactory. Artists began flocking to this scenic locale in the 1890s, creating one of the oldest continually operating artist colonies in the nation. A great many American artists of note painted on Rocky Neck, among them Fitz Henry Lane, Winslow Homer, Frank Duveneck, Childe Hassam, Jane Peterson, Edward Hopper, Stuart Davis and Milton Avery.

Dozens of working artists from painters, potters and textile designers to photographers and jewelry makers, display their work in Rocky Neck galleries during the summer months. A variety of restaurants are available to suit every taste with live entertainment enhancing the ambiance in restaurants and bars on weekends and on the first Thursday of each month, from June to September. Rocky Neck offers an eclectic mixture of history and culture—a great place to stroll on a lazy summer day, to include in a day trip to the beach, or to enjoy a memorable meal.

ROCKY NECK HISTORIC ART TRAIL

By mapping the sites where they worked, lived, and became inspired, the Rocky Neck Historic Art Trail enables you to walk in the footsteps of Winslow Homer, Fitz Henry Lane, Marsden Hartley, Edward Hopper, and a host of other pioneering American artists.

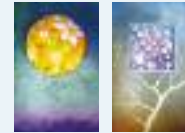
