



# Rocky Neck Goes to Town

## Rocky Neck Art Colony's 7th Annual Winter Show

November 18 - December 29, 2011

Entry Form : Must be received by November 11, 2011

The Rocky Neck Art Colony Winter Show will be open Friday Nov. 18 through Thursday Dec. 29 at 130 Main Street. The opening reception is Sat., Dec. 3, from 5 to 8pm.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Winter Exhibit is open to all Rocky Neck Art Colony members who have paid their dues for 2011 or 2012 and the \$10 entry fee. Each 2D artist may submit 3 wall pieces and 10 bin pieces. There will be no exceptions. Ceramic artists and jewelers may submit as many pieces as will fit comfortably in display cases, including ornaments. Artists may submit as many greeting cards as will fit in card racks.

**REQUIREMENTS:** All work must be original and created by the artist within the last two years. Paintings, mixed-media, sculpture, assemblage, photography, printmaking, fine crafts including jewelry, and greeting cards are eligible. No giclee prints or reproductions (except for greeting cards and photographs). Two dimensional work must be suitably framed and firmly wired. No sawtooth hangers or sandwich frames. Bin work and greeting cards must be shrink wrapped or in plastic sleeves. All work must be for sale and clearly marked with retail price. If we don't have enough room to display all work submitted, the hanging committee will decide what will be hung. If any of your work sells, you may replace it with a piece of similar size. You may not replace or remove work that has not sold. All participants are required to gallery sit. If you cannot sit we ask that you find a replacement or you may opt out of gallery sitting by paying an additional fee to be collected at drop-off.

**ENTRY PROCEDURE:** This is a non-juried show. All work will be accepted and will be hung as space allows. Entry forms must be received no later than Friday, Nov. 11, 2011. Deliver work to the Winter Show Gallery (130 Main St.) on Sat., Nov. 12 or Mon, Nov. 14 (11am -2pm). Also bring your bio, resumé/artist statement and business cards for display in gallery.

**FEES/COMMISSIONS:** There is a \$10 entry fee. The Rocky Neck Art Colony will keep 30% commission on all work sold. You may pick up unsold work on Friday, Dec. 30, 12 noon to 2pm.

**LIABILITY:** Artists are responsible for insuring their work. The Rocky Neck Art Colony will take all reasonable precautions to preserve submitted work from damage, theft or other harm but cannot accept liability if any such event occurs.
